DEAR SIR,

A number of Members of this Committee have recently been in Macedonia, and they will be glad to address meetings during the winter months. There is the greatest need that the public of this country should show themselves interested in the question at the present time, as the reforms so far introduced into Macedonia have proved entirely inadequate. The condition of the miserable inhabitants is worse than ever, and more vigorous action on the part of the European Powers is an urgent necessity. Should you be able to secure a meeting in your neighbourhood, or to have the Macedonian Question chosen as the subject in one of any series of lectures or meetings in connection with any society or institute, we should be glad to send a speaker. Lantern Lectures can be given where desired.

I hope very much that it may be possible for you to help our work in this direction.

The Macedonian Relief Fund is in need of further assistance for the devastated villages, and in cases where there would be no objection to this course, the Committee would be grateful to the promoters of the meeting if a collection for this purpose might be taken up.
